While homelessness remains visible in our community, we are making a difference! 40 Prado continued to show results and has made a positive impact in our community through its work for individuals and families by providing meals, medical care, and wrap around services needed for the most vulnerable among us. This year 40 Prado made the decision to add additional beds and 125 participants can now be served a night, compared to 100 participants previously.

Without this great community's contributions, the most vulnerable would not get the help they really need. Homelessness touches all of us in different ways, and your support helps keep the shelter open and all of the programs going. It can be a helpless feeling to be homeless, yet thousands find themselves in this predicament in San Luis Obispo County every day. Fortunately, our compassionate community has found an effective way to provide services to assist the homeless. The 40 Prado Homeless Services Center provides a safe, central location for homeless families and individuals as they embark on the path to self-sufficiency. In addition to the basic essentials of food, shelter and personal care, program participants will also receive counseling, job training, tutoring, healthcare, Veterans services and assistance with finding permanent housing.

Many 40 Prado clients have furry friends. Fortunately, the staff and volunteers at this one of a kind center understand how important these pets are to their owners. Studies have shown that pets can be the main source of emotional support for homeless people.

Pets are loving companions that help to combat feelings of loneliness, and they provide a relationship of trust and affection. Also, the responsibility that comes from caring for a pet, can provide a sense of purpose in life. In order to help keep owners and pets together, 40 Prado has kennels on site where residents may house their special friends during their stay at the center. Additionally, case managers at 40 Prado go the extra mile to secure pet-friendly permanent housing so that when clients are able to move towards their new lives, they can do so with their loving companions by their side.
