Spring has been very busy at 40 Prado! In March, the Access Center served an average of 148 persons per day. The Shelter program hosted an average of 107 persons/night and turned away 0 individuals due to overcapacity. There were 19 unduplicated children, with an average of 11 children/night. The shelter served 130 dinners/night, including Community Dinners & Warming Center dinners.

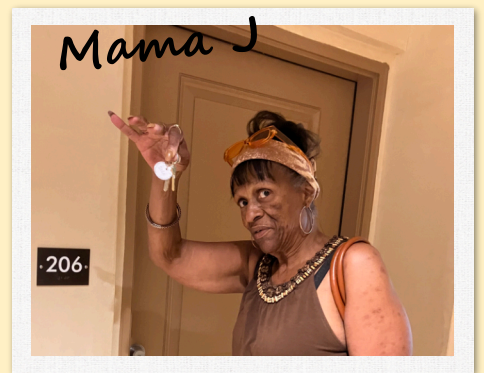

Congratulations to all the members of the team for this successful housing transition. **Mama J** has officially signed her lease and has moved into her new federally subsidized, permanent supportive housing!

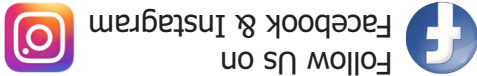
40 Prado Producing Amazing Results!

These are just some of the things accomplished at 40 Prado in the month of March:

- Maintained a housing rate of at least one household housed every 2.27 days.
- Enrolled 93 clients in Day Habilitation, a CenCal Community Supports Program that allows Prado to use the provided resources for the Access Center!
- Over 400 clients used services at the Access Center, and 270 clients used the shelter and safe parking programs.
- 52 clients accessed services for the first time.
- Warming Center was open ten nights, serving an average of 30 people per night.
- The Housing-Focused Shelter Program had 70 households enrolled with an assigned Navigator.
- The Recuperative Care Program served 13 unduplicated medically fragile participants, with an average of 10 participants/night.
